

Thank you for enquiring about enrolling at Oamaru Doctors.

How to enrol?

To enrol you must be eligible, entitled and are required to complete the 2 pages of our enrolment form.

The first page contains your personal information including your next of kin or emergency contact required and previous GP.

A transfer of notes will be requested for all patients. Unfortunately we are unable to request notes from overseas GPs. These will need to be requested by the patient to their overseas GP.

The second page is a tick box to confirm your eligibility for publicly funded health services – please do not be offended when we ask.

Proof of eligibility is required by the patient signing the form to confirm their identification.

Identification required: A valid passport (work visa) or driver's licence will be held on file.

We also request all NZ citizens to provide evidence – this can be a valid driver's licence, community services card, gold card or a letter or bill addressed to your current address.

Enrolling children (under 16 years)

Parents can enrol and sign for children under 16 years of age, but children over 16 years or over must sign their own enrolment form.

Oamaru Doctors also provides each patient with our Health Information Statement covering why we collect your information and how that information will be used. Please feel free to keep this information.
